

There were 307 donors who showed up to donate. Of those One Blood was able to collect 276 pints of blood which tied us with our February Drive total. Bringing our yearly total to 837 pints or 104 Gallons. Our 21 Volunteers brought our Volunteer hours up to 440 hrs for the year. 2021 VILLAGES PARROTHEADS MEMBERSHIPS


HERE'S HOW TO PAY YOUR MEMBERSHIP:

To pay your membership, go to our ON LINE Payment system. You access that through our VILLAG-ESPARROTHEADS website. (Villagesparrotheads.com).


You'll find these icons on the Home Page and the Membership page. Clicking on them will take you directly to the screen for Joining and paying your membership.



Here's the screen. On the left side, you will see instructions. The first step for NEW MEMBERS is to click on the ABOUT icon. (renewals simply skip to the next screen.




You'll then see Member Guidelines to read. Please read them. You will be asked to confirm that you have read them when you complete your registration.



Click on the "TICKETS" icon to join. Follow the instructions on the left side of the page. The first step is to click on the ICON that says TICKETS.






This screen is where you will select which tickets you want. NOTE: The tickets that are ON SALE have an arrow next to them. The other dates are FUTURE SALES.

Once you have selected how many tickets (remember, it says tickets, but it means memberships) you want, you can either edit the amount, or click on CHECKOUT




Enter in your information. Just follow the prompts.



YOU WILL NEED TO ENTER YOUR UNIQUE ID.- This number will be used every time you purchase a ticket to any VILLAGES PARROTHEADS event. If you are a Villager, you already have your ID. It is on your Villager Card and is the SAME ONE you use every time you play golf, buy tickets to places like The Sharon or The Savanah Center.

If you are NOT a VILLAGER, we've made it easy. Just use your first name and your address number. NO SPACES. EXAMPLE: My name is Mark Goldberg and I live at 868 Wiechens Way. So, if I did not live in The Villages, my unique ID would be MARK868. It is easy to create and easy to remember.

NOTE: At the end of this document are more detailed instructions on creating your ID number.



Once you complete your application, you will receive a confirmation email. CONGRATULATIONS, YOU ARE NOW A MEMBER OF THE LARGEST AND BEST PARROTHEAD CLUB IN THE WORLD and one of the BEST CLUBS IN THE VILLAGES.

ENTER YOUR UNIQUE ID

We have several members that have similar or exact same names. This can create problems when you sign up for events.

To avoid that, we need your UNIQUE ID.

When you use our ON-LINE TICKETING SYSTEM, you will be asked for your ID. PLEASE, always use the same one.


HERE IS HOW TO CREATE IT:

VILLAGERS: Your **UNIQUE ID** is found on your **VILLAGE ID CARD**. Please use this each time you are asked for your **VIIIage ID**. In the example below, your ID is **368145**.



NON-VILLAGERS: If you do not have a Village ID, Create your UNIQUE ID by using your FIRST NAME+YOUR ADDRESS NUMBER. DO NOT INCLUDE YOUR STREET NAME, ONLY THE NUMBER.

(note: if done correctly, this will be UNIQUE TO YOU). In the example below, your ID is FRED (first name)+1100 (address number)= **FRED1100.**



WHEN COMPLETING YOUR MEMBERSHIP ON LINE THIS IS WHAT THE FIELD TO NETER YOUR ID LOOKS LIKE.
